ABOUT HCSSC

TRAINING FRAMEWORK

Comprehensive Training for Industry Excellence

HCSSC provides structured training across five key areas:

1. Training of Master Trainers (ToMT)

- Trains experienced domain experts to lead Training of Trainers (ToT) programmes.

2. Training of Master Assessors (ToMA)

- Trains skilled industry experts to conduct Training of Assessors (ToA) programmes.

3. Training of Trainers (ToT)

- Skill enhancement for trainers
- Focus on pedagogy and industry alignment

4. Training of Assessors (ToA)

- Builds capacity for fair and standardised assessment

5. Training of Trainees

- Fresh training and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)
- Delivered by affiliated partners for various crafts

QUALIFICATION PACK (QP)

A QP is a formal document defining job-specific skills, knowledge, and performance criteria. It consists of related NOS and is mapped to the **National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF)**.

- Used for all kinds of training such as STT and RPL
- Credit Framework as per the New Education Policy (NEP 2020) in accordance with the NCVET guidelines

ROLES OF TRAINER & ASSESSOR

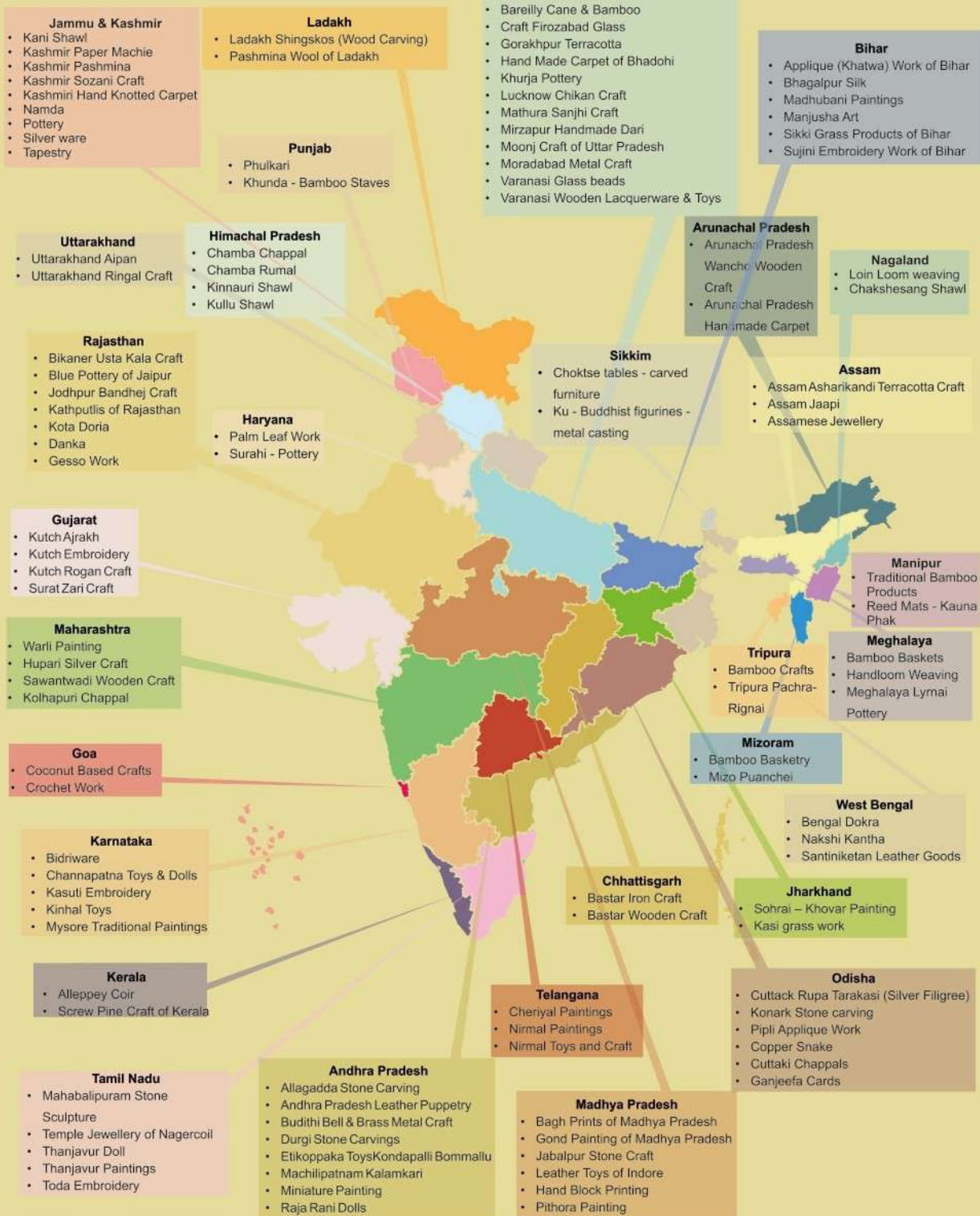
Ensuring Quality in Skill Development

- **Assessor:** Evaluates candidates as per NOSs

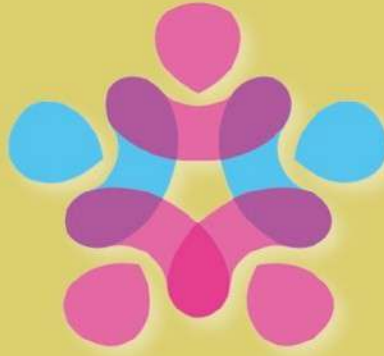
BENEFITS FOR THE INDUSTRY
